Where is the BBQ?

The BBQ is being held at our new children's hospice.

Address: Alexander Devine Children's Hospice, Snowball Hill, Maidenhead, Berkshire, SL6 3LU

Directions: From the M4 exit at junction 8/9 to Maidenhead. Take the A404 towards Maidenhead and High Wycombe. Take the first exit 9A towards Cox Green and White Waltham. Turn right onto Shoppenhangers Road and go straight over the first mini roundabout and turn left (1st exit) at the second roundabout onto Woodlands Park Road. After approximately 1 mile turn left onto Woodlands Park Avenue. Follow the road to the end passing a small industrial unit and some new housing on the left. Continue onto the track and the drive to the hospice is on your left.

Is there parking at the hospice?

There is parking available on site but it is limited. Some cars may need to be parked on the roadside at the bottom of the drive. Please be considerate to our new neighbours.

Can I see inside the hospice?

You are very welcome to view the hospice. We are running guided tours throughout the afternoon that can be pre-booked on line at www.alexanderdevine.org or by calling 01628 822777. If spaces are available then please do come and join a tour on the day.

I have pre-booked a guided tour. What shall I do when I arrive?

Please go to our registration desk where we can confirm the time of your tour. Please meet by the front door a few minutes before your tour begins.

Children are welcome at the BBQ. Please note that the hospice is on a large site and much of the ground is uneven and not suitable for play. You will need to be responsible for your children at all times.
